

## Conference travel and lodging.

### Getting to Bellingham.

1. Your best option, if feasible, is to drive.
2. Fly directly into Bellingham! Then probably a rental, cab, or uber to get around
3. Flying into SeaTac (Seattle's airport). About 100 miles south of Bellingham.
  - a. Rent a car.
  - b. Take the airporter shuttle <https://airporter.com/shuttle/schedules/bellingham-to-seatac/>
  - c. Bus, train, etc, check this out: <https://www.rome2rio.com/s/SeaTac/Bellingham>
4. Note, for those along the west coast, Amtrak runs from San Diego all the way to Bellingham.

### Hotels:

- Use your favorite travel website (expedia, Airbnb, etc); we haven't booked any blocks of rooms.

### Getting to campus:

- It's a bit of a walk from most hotels, the closest are about 2 miles from the conference location.
- Depending on where you stay, there may be bus options. <https://schedules.ridewta.com/>
